

REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

Hickman County Government is requesting proposals for public Wi-Fi services and a splash page for users accessing the public Wi-Fi network.

Proposals will be accepted by hand delivery or mail to the Hickman County Finance Office, 114 North Central Ave, Suite 203, Centerville, TN 37033. Envelope must be clearly marked "SEALED PROPOSAL FOR WIFI SERVICES FOR PUBLIC BROADBAND SYSTEM". Proposals will be opened on Tuesday, August 25th, 2026 at 2:00 PM in the Finance Office. Any proposals received after the scheduled closing time will be rejected.

Scope:

- Public Wi-Fi services must be available for public use for a continuous period of three (3) years. The service must be reliable, continual, and suitable for public access at the listed locations.
- A custom splash page must represent Hickman County and appear when members of the public join the Wi-Fi network.

Locations:

- Hickman County Agricultural Pavilion
- Centerville Public Square

Interested applicants are encouraged to schedule a site visit.

Submittal Requirements:

- Proposals must provide a lump sum bid for the full three-year service period. Monthly pricing will not be accepted.
- Completed bid sheet
- Wi-Fi Speeds
- Surface Area of Wi-Fi Coverage

General Conditions:

Submittals must be in compliance with this RFP. Failure to comply with all provisions of the RFP may result in disqualification.

Vendor selection will be based upon the lowest and most responsive bid deemed by Hickman County Government. Hickman County Government reserves the right to reject all proposals.

All vendors must comply with A.D.A. guidelines if required.

All vendors must be in compliance with Title VI, Civil Rights Act of 1964, which specifies that: No person in the United States shall, on the grounds of race, color or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under a program or activity receiving federal financial assistance from the Department of Transportation or the U. S. Department of Justice.

Failure on the part of a vendor to comply with all instructions herein may result in proposal rejection.

All bid/proposal submissions to Hickman County Government are subject to inspection and reproduction pursuant to the Tennessee Public Records Act ("TPRA"), T.C.A. section 10-7-501, et seq. Hickman County Government provides access to public records upon request in full compliance with TPRA.
